Special case to be clarified: Tunisia Enfidha and Monastir Airport tenders

TAV Airports Holding was awarded the tender for the operation of the Enfidha Airport and Monastir Airport, in Tunisia. The operation of both airports will be carried out by TAV Airports Holding for 40 years. As per the tender specifications, TAV Airports Holding will undertake the operation of Tunisia Monastir Airport in January 2008, and the operation of the Tunisia Enfidha Airport during the first half of 2009.

TAV Airports Holding will invest approximately 400 million Euros for the first two years operations of the two airports. The investment is expected to be completed during the first half of 2009, with which Tunisia Enfidha Airport will be completed to serve with an annual passenger capacity of 7,000,000. Throughout the operation period, four stages of activities will be undertaken, to increase this figure to 22,000,000.

Tunisia Monastir airport is at 60 km distance to the Tunisia Enfidha Airport with a current passenger capacity of 3.5 million, although the number of international passengers served reaches 4.5 million per year.
