Special case to be clarified: The press coverage on March 1, 2007.

On March 1, 2007, it is stated in the press that "15 Euros arrival money charged from the tourists that arrive in Turkey, and that this will be shared equally with the Ministry of Transportation".

Our company collects a 15-USD service charge from the international departing passengers at the Istanbul Atatürk Airport, and 15 Euros at the Ankara Esenboğa and İzmir Adnan Menderes airports. Such charges are set forth through the concession agreements executed between our company and the DHMI (State Airports Authority), and will not change throughout the concession period. The articles in the press do not reflect the reality, and our company does not have any service revenues from the arriving passengers as indicated in the press.

There are no decisions at this stage for lowering the service charges of Havas, 60% participation of our company , and there are no special cases that require a public statement.

We hereby declare that the above explanations are in compliance with the principles set forth in the Communique No. 39, Series: VIII of the Capital Market Board, that they accurately reflect the information we have received on this matter/these matters; that they are in compliance with our records and books; that we have spent every effort to ensure that the relevant information is accurate and authentic; and that we are responsible for these explanations.
